Editorial Board: Call for Self-Nominations

The *Journal of Evidence-Informed Social Work* is pleased to announce the appointment of Bruce A. Thyer, Ph.D., LCSW, as a new Co-Editor of the journal, joining the existing Co-Editor and journal founder, John S. Wodarski, Ph.D. Invitations are extended to members of the social work academic, practice and research communities to apply for a three-year appointment to the journal's new Editorial Board, for the period 2017-2019. Editorial Board members should be professional social workers with a background commensurate with the journal's purposes. This would normally include receipt of a doctoral degree, post-MSW practice experience, and having authored a number of scholarly publications related to social work. Editorial Board members are expected to use the *Journal Article Reporting Standards* found in the latest edition of the *APA Style Manual*, as appropriate, in preparing their analyses of data-based submissions. In addition, knowledge and support of the principles of evidence-informed practice and the work of the Cochrane and Campbell Collaborations is preferred. Editorial Board members are expected to accept for review no more than six issues per year and to make use of the journal's web-based portal known as *ScholarOne* to receive manuscripts and to submit their reviews. New Editorial Board members should be available to receive manuscripts for review beginning in January 2017. Usually, each week the Co-Editors will send an email to the Editorial Board announcing what papers are available for review, and Editorial Board members **self-select** the papers they wish to review.

Interested social workers are invited to email a cover letter expressing an interest in being appointed to the Editorial Board, along with a current c.v., (both formatted in Word), to Co-Editor Bruce A. Thyer, Ph.D., LCSW, at Bthyer@fsu.edu. Accepted applicants will be notified of their appointment and provided detailed guidelines for preparing their blind peer reviews.
